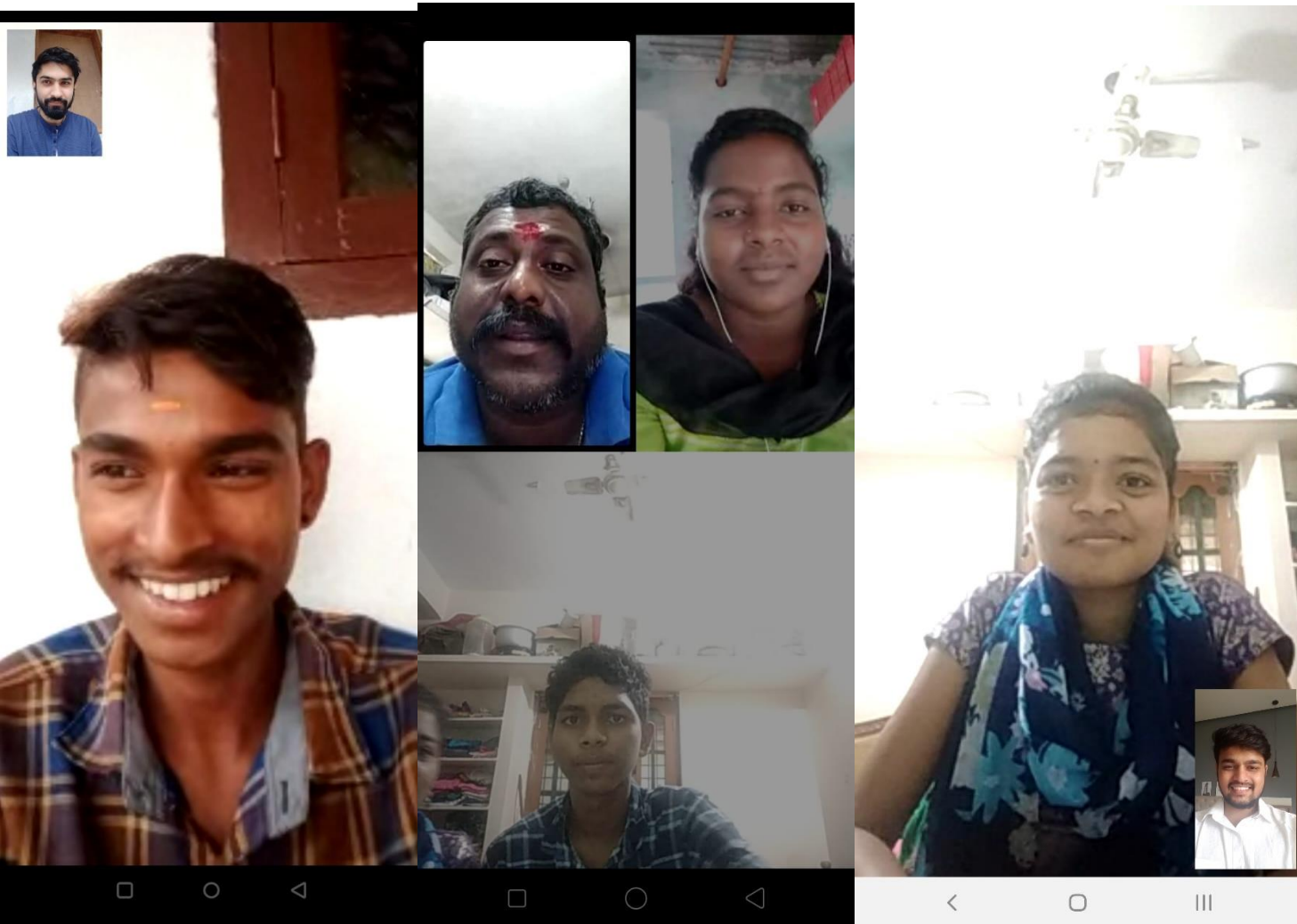
Volunteers in Delhi conducted a 'Painting Workshop' for children

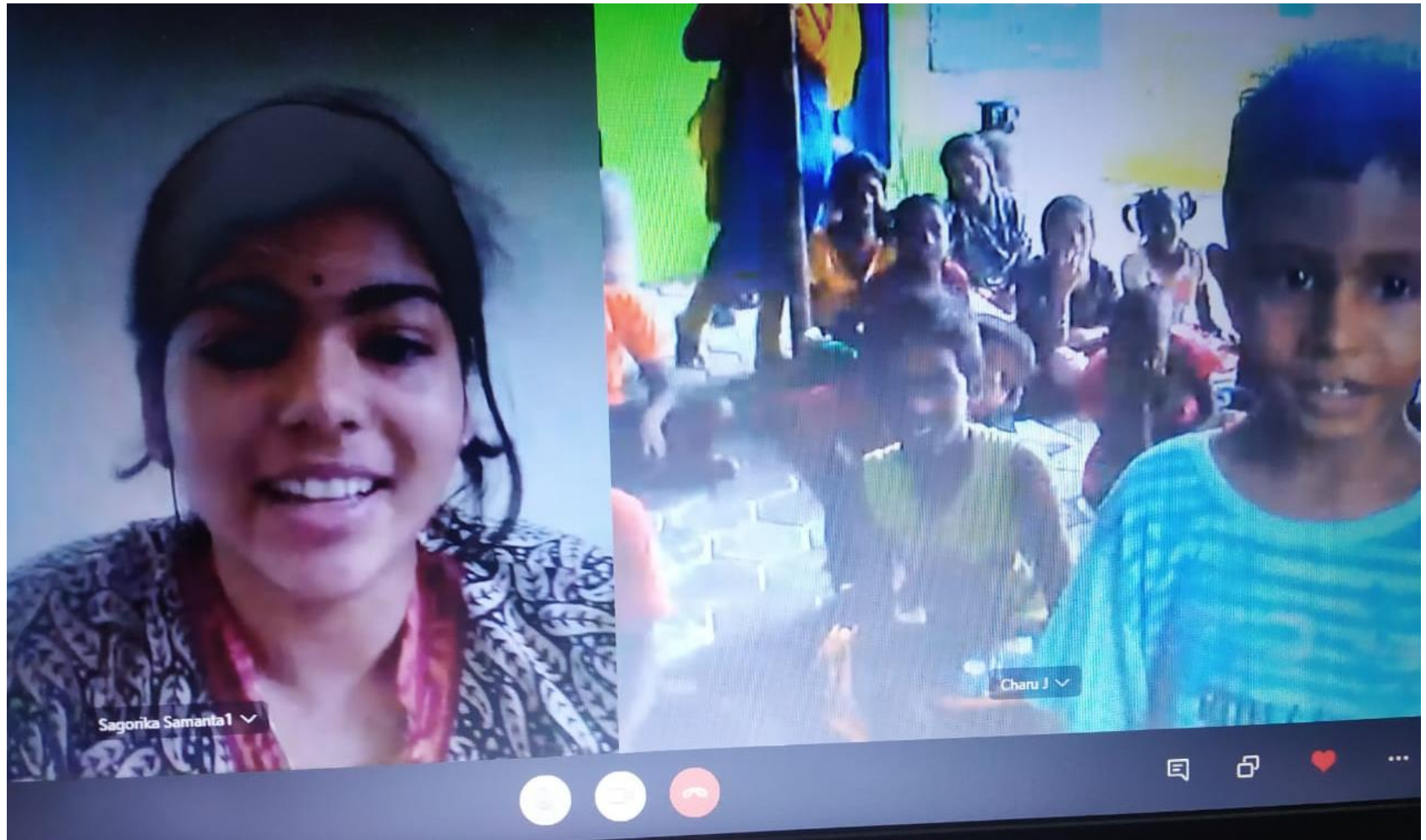
A digital marathon was organised wherein for every completion of 5 km from the volunteers, the company promised to donate a PPE kit to a front-line health worker

Volunteers visited an orphanage to spend some quality time and donate essentials items



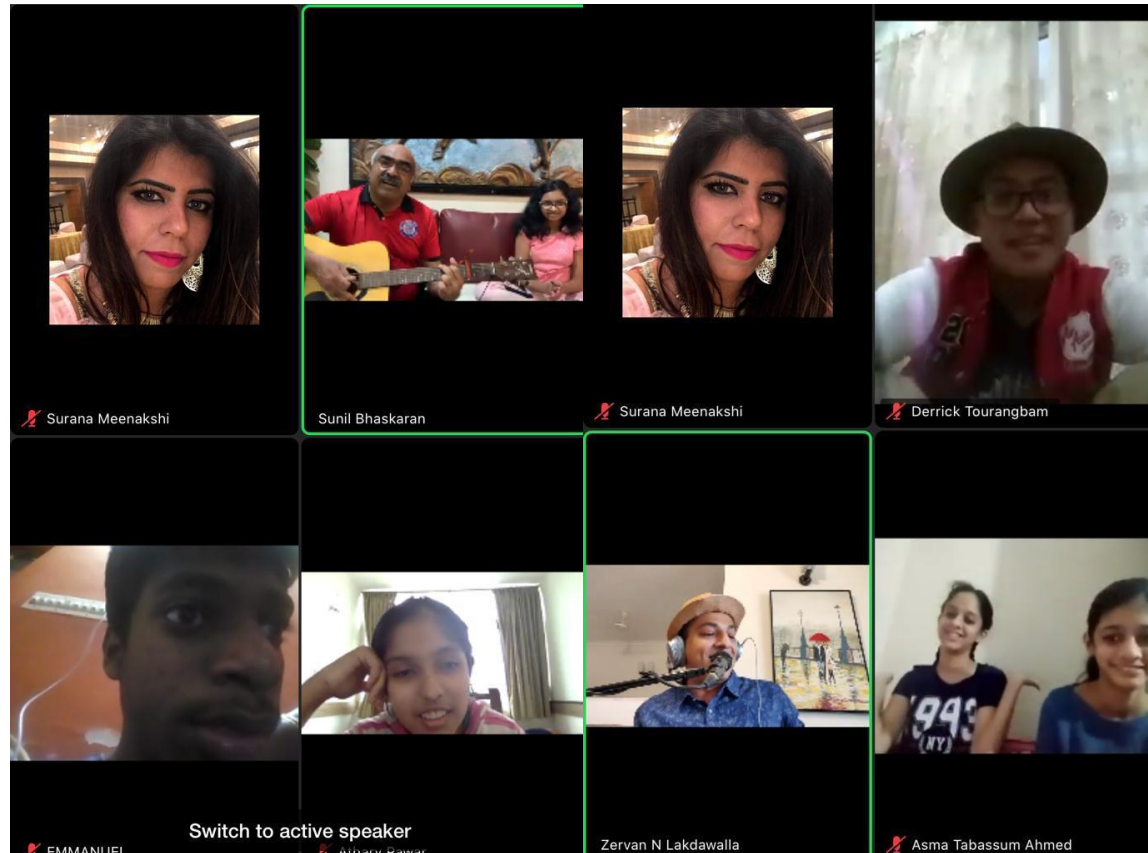
Mumbai volunteers facilitated an extra curricular activity program for the kids at St. Mathew's school, Malad

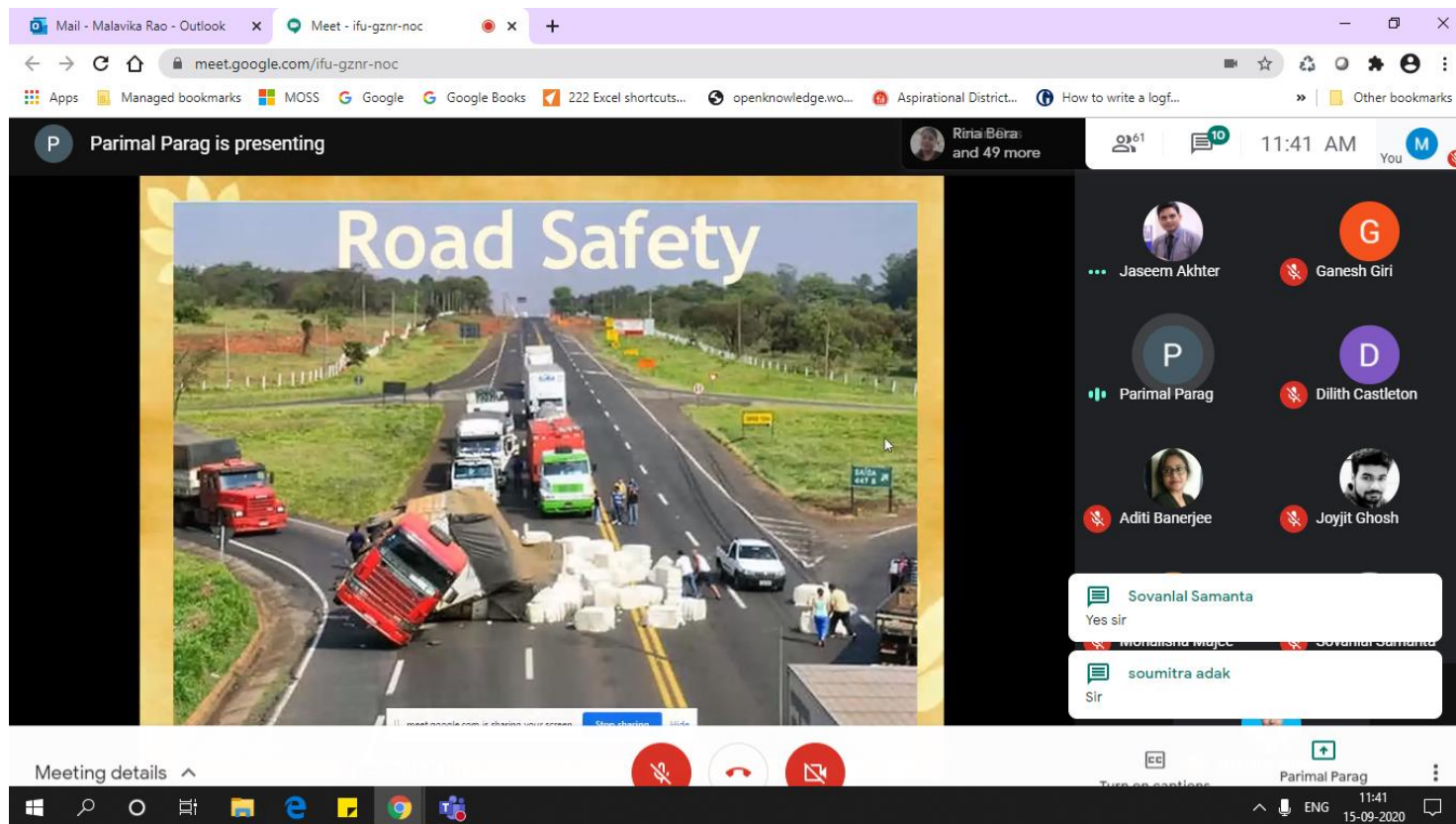
